The **SASLAW 26<sup>th</sup> Annual National Conference** will take place in Cape Town at *The Cape Town International Convention Centre (CTICC)* on the **13 & 14 September 2023** and you are invited to **forward your submission – CALL FOR PAPERS – 2023!**

The theme for this year will be

**“Environmental/ Social /Governance (ESG)”**

and the impact on the employment and labour environment in South Africa and across the globe.

**There will be 2 presentation platforms available to consider and choose from:**

1. In person LIVE presentation at the venue; OR
2. Pre-recorded Presentation

#### **LIVE Presentation at the venue**

- The Speaker will present at the physical event during an allocated slot on either the 13th or 14th September 2023.
- Content will be shared from the stage to a live audience at the specified time.
- The session will be recorded by a videographer and relayed out to the virtual conference platform.
- You have the option of presenting your topic as a workshop, panel discussion or Plenary session.

#### **Pre-recorded Presentation**

- The Speaker may book a Studio slot on a specified day where they will deliver their presentation to a technical crew, book a recording slot on a video conference link or provide an edited and completed presentation
- These presentations need to be provided no less than two weeks before the live event to allow for editing
- The session will be streamed, as live, in the dedicated programme slot

## Questions and Answers and Audience Engagement

- Speakers are asked to be available on the conference platform on the day to handle questions at their session on the chat function.

**Should you be interested in presenting via one of these platforms, please indicate the following information on the google form:**

- Forward a proposed title of your topic;
- Indicate which platform you propose to present - Live Presentation or Pre-recorded Presentation
- A short outline of what you envisage the content of your presentation will be;
- A short biographical paragraph and photograph of yourself for the Mobi App; and
- Contact details

### **More points to note:**

The topic chosen should allow for interactive conversation, via the platforms, with practical workplace solutions and for the presenter to facilitate the discussion.

1. When considering which presentations will be selected, consideration will be given to the relevance and interest of the topic to the platform as well as whether this topic has been presented before.
2. The SASLAW Conference committee may have to ask speakers to co-present if the topics are similar and reserves the right to move the presentation to a different platform to balance the programme.
3. Kindly submit your forms by the **30 March 2023**.
